Pharmacists are medication experts trained to understand how medications work in your body, and to identify medication interactions and problems. Pharmacists can look at all of the medications you take, including non-prescription medications, and help you determine if your medications are doing what they are supposed to do.

Pharmacists can also provide medication reviews. Many people take medications prescribed by different physicians for many medical problems which could lead to medication duplications. That is why it is important to have a regular review of your medications by your physician or your pharmacist. If at all possible, use the same pharmacy for all of your medication needs. Ask your pharmacist when you have questions about your drugs or drug costs. They may suggest another drug to you and to your physician that could save you money.
